

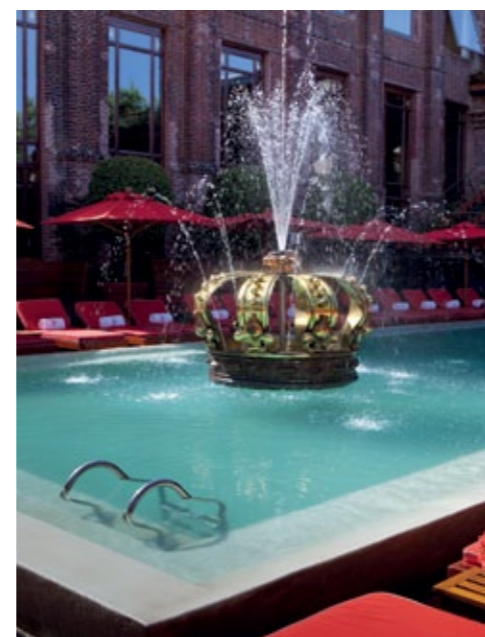

CONTEMPORARY HERITAGE

Formerly the Berlin home of the Danish Embassy and now a member of Design Hotels, Das Stue features 1930s architecture that reflects the grandeur of its heritage while maintaining both its social buzz and the privacy so treasured by the former residents. Its 80 rooms and suites come in a variety of layouts and designs to suit single travellers, romantic breaks or family get-togethers. Clean, contemporary lines are layered against plush colours and rich prints for an atmosphere of unfussy glamour, infused with prints by legendary photographers such as Helmut Newton, Horst P Horst and Cindy Sherman.
